Forklift Seats - A sturdy surface to sit down is known as a seat. These Seats are usually raised above floor level and nearly all seats use four legs and could carry a single individual. A stool is a kind of seat which does not have any arm rests or a back rest. A kind of seat which has folding action and an inclining footrest is called a recliner, whereas a seat along with arms only is considered an arm seat. When a seat has attached wheels, it can be called a wheelseat and if the seat is hung from above, it is referred to as a swing. A permanently connected seat in a train or a theatre is referred to as a seat or airline seat, yet when riding; it is a saddle as in bicycle saddle. A car seat is the kind used in vehicles and an infant car seat will be a seat particularly designed for young children.

The design of the seat can differ rather significantly in order to accommodate several aesthetic tastes and requirements. As an example, designs could be decorated with drilled openings, could comprise gaps or low backs for ventilation or be made of porous materials. The seat back may be designed as an included headrest by extending the height over the occupant's head. Seats may be constructed with an attached, built in footrest or come with a separate matching ottoman. An ottoman is a short stool which is designed to be utilized as a movable footrest. From time to time the ottoman could be mounted to a glider chair with swing arms, enabling the ottoman to rock back and forth together with the glider similar to a rocking chair along with a built-in footrest.

Seat covers are temporary cloth covers for a seat that can provide protection against wear and add attractiveness. A huge variety of seat covers from leather to neoprene are now obtainable. More formal materials could be rented for occasions like for example weddings to be able to increase the decor. Several seat covers have decorative seat ties or ribbons attached to be tied behind the seat in a bow or decorative knot. Some people use custom clear plastic furniture covers to protect their pricey sofas and seats.

Seat pads are cushions intended for seats, often decorative; they could also be used within vehicles so as to add to the drivers' height. Orthopaedic backrests give support for the back, frequently in lumbar or lower spine region.
