Cascade Clamps - Established in Portland, Oregon in the year 1943, the Cascade Manufacturing Company started as a small machine shop hiring just four people. Overall sales for that year amounted to about \$60,000. The first recorded sales revenues involved the machining and assembly of stainless steel pipe fittings, valves and different parts. Within five years of operation, the business had stretched to 40 employees and their yearly sales volume had risen to \$330,000. Nowadays, Cascade is amongst the leading worldwide makers within the material handling business.

Design and manufacturing of the company's initial hydraulic cylinder allowed this young business to aggressively pursue better business possibilities. Throughout the final sixty years, the business of material handling has developed into a really sophisticated area with Cascade proudly playing a part in its growth. Cascade currently continues to grow as the leader provider of forklift accessories and various related items. The business feels certain in their skill to continue to lead the way within the business by understanding client's needs in the future and remaining aggressive in the world market.

All through the nineteen fifties, Cascade started to manufacture, design, and advertise its hydraulic attachments. A new facility was constructed in 1956, to be able to accommodate all the plant offices and operations in Portland, Oregon, which is still the company's current center of operations. After 15 years of business, total employees reached a hundred and eighty staff and sales had reached almost two million three hundred thousand dollars.

The next production plant was built in 1959 in Springfield, Ohio. nineteen sixty marked Cascade's initial move into the global world of the material handling industry when the business established interest in England, Australia, and the Netherlands.

The company changed its name to Cascade Corporation in the year 1964. In the year 1965, Cascade went public with a preliminary offering of 200,000 shares of common stock. The company has expanded its production plants within the United States with locations in Springfield, Ohio, Warner Robins, Georgia, Portland, Oregon. Cascade products are made internationally due to many subsidiary operations. In the year 1944, a new facility was completed in Almere, the Netherlands which is Cascade's European headquarters. This facility is built to be the ultimate customer support centre.

Continuing to develop, Cascade expanded their product offering further in the year 1996 and 1997 with the remarkable acquisition of five firms, along with the global best in forks, the Kenhar Corporation.
