

Side Tilt Carriage

Side Tilt Carriage - There are actually 4 sizes of hook type blade carriages rated by the fork carriage lifting capacity. Hook type tine carriages have been the same.

Class I carriages are rated for cargo as much as 2000 lbs. The carriage bar spacing utilized for Class I is thirteen inches. Class II carriages are rated for cargo as much as 5,550 lbs. Their carriage bar spacing is 16 inches. Class III carriages are rated for cargo as much as 10,000 lbs. The carriage bar spacing for this class is twenty inches. Class IV carriages are rated for cargo up to 15,500 lbs. The carriage bar spacing for this capacity is twenty five inches.

The carriages for pin type tines may be different depending on the maker. Pin mounted forks may vary by the amount of offset between the blade eye and the blade. Carriage capacity would be established by the carriage pin size and by the tine size.
